

### **Flying In to Serve? Here's What to Pack.**

- \*Up-to-date passport
- \*Shower supplies, towel and washcloth (shower shoes/flip flops, optional)
- \*Twin bed sheets and pillow case (pillows provided)  
*Sheets and one bath towel can be provided for an additional \$5; please reserve in advance and bring cash payment.*
- \*Basic clothing: underwear, socks, pajamas
- \*Work clothes: 5 tee shirts, 2 pairs of long pants, closed-toe shoes (tennis shoes OK)  
*NO shorts at work sites, please, for safety reasons.*
- \*Work gloves, safety goggles, personal tools
- \*Casual clothes for evenings (Long pants are protective against hungry mosquitoes!)
- \*Sun protection: hat, bandana, sunscreen
- \*Swimsuit and beach towel
- \*Bible, paper, pen, journal
- \*Camera
- \*Tennis shoes (must have closed-toe shoes)
- \*Bug spray (hot and buggy weather: DEET repels mosquitoes; Skin-So-Soft repels sand fleas)
- \*Anti-itch cream or Benadryl cream
- \*Flashlight with extra batteries
- \*Hand sanitizer or wipes
- \*Water bottle for work site
- \*Small, battery-operated, personal fan (optional)
- \*Personal funds: for meals while traveling, snacks on island, souvenirs, Excursion Day Lunch (\$10), love offerings at church and/or for Bahamas Habitat and Bahamas Methodist Habitat

### **Please, Do Not Bring,**

- \*Video games and other electronic devices
- \*Expensive items you'd hate to lose
- \*Nice clothes
- \*Fragrances (perfumes, cologne and scented lotions attract bugs)
